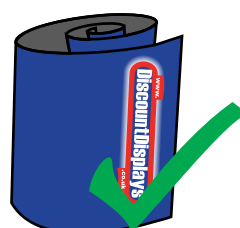


Caring For Your Exhibition Graphics

Your printed graphics will last a long time providing that they are cared for properly. Here are some helpful hints on how to get the maximum use out of your displays.

Pop-Up Stands

Always loosely roll your graphics with the printed side facing the outside. This is very important as rolling the graphics with the printed side inwards can result in permanent and irreparable creasing of the laminate.



Graphics should be wrapped in bubble wrap or similar and should be stored in the pop-up drum or a graphics case when not in use.

Graphics should not be exposed to moisture, extreme heat or cold and they should not be exposed to direct sunlight for long periods of time.



Pop-up stands should be easy to dismantle and excessive force should not need to be used. If the stand will not compact down easily please check that all of the vertical magnetic bars have been removed.

If you haven't used your pop-up stand for a while we would recommend that you assemble your stand a few days before your event to make sure that everything is satisfactory.

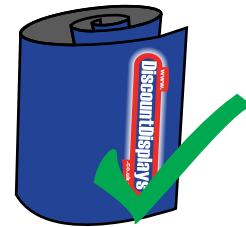
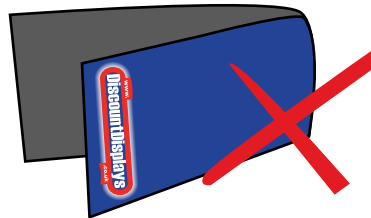

Banner Stands

Roller/Pull-Up Banners

It is really important that you don't let the graphic go once you have disconnected it from the rear pole, as the graphic will retract with such force that it may be damaged and it may damage the stand as well. The graphic should slowly retract into the base.

Graphics should never be folded or bent as this can cause irreparable creasing of the laminate.



Graphics should not be exposed to moisture, extreme heat or cold and they should not be exposed to direct sunlight for long periods of time.



The banner should pull up and down easily, if it is difficult to pull up and down please don't force it as this may damage the graphic or the spring mechanism in the base.

The stand should be stored in the carry bag that is supplied when not in use. Please note that the carry bag will not provide adequate protection during transportation and we would recommend that the stand is wrapped in bubble wrap or similar when it is being transported.

If you have not used your banner stand for a while we would recommend that you assemble it a few days before your event to make sure that everything is in order.
